"Run Like a Tortoise"

Where Y'at? Make an assessment

- -God's people had been captured by Babylon
- -Jerusalem was in shambles
- -Nehemiah hears the bad news (Neh 1:1-3)
- -He specifically inquires about his people and Jerusalem
- -Nehemiah weeps, fasts and prays (Neh 1:4)
- -Save the Dates: Jan 8 Feb 5
- -Nehemiah begins privately before God alone (Neh 1:5)
- -He continues to wait on God (Neh 2:11)
- -He assesses the situation (Neh 2:12-16)

Crunch Time - Make a Plan

- -Begin with the end in sight
- -Nehemiah's plan includes others (Neh 2:17)
- -God commands us to stay connected (1 Cor 12:21)
- -Nehemiah's plan is attacked (Neh 2:19)
- -We do not wrestle with flesh and blood (Eph 6:10-12)
- -Our plan should include spiritual armor (Eph 6:14-15)
- -Include God's truth (v14)
- -Include God's righteousness (v14)
- -Include a method of sharing Christ (v15)
- -Avoid the sin that weighs you down (Heb 12:1)
- -Ask God to help you make your plan

Just Do It - Make a move

- -Nehemiah and the people begin the work
- -Each person mattered (Neh 4:16-17)
- -You must believe that You matter to God
- -Nehemiah had a great attitude (Neh 4:15-20)
- -He was not intimidated by the enemy (Neh 4:15)
- -He trusted in Almighty God (Neh 4:20)
- -God cares more about the relationship than the task
