Matthew The Gospel of the Kingdom

Before the End - Matthew 25:1-46

The Virgins - The parable of the ten virgins (Matt 25:1-13)
Jesus speaks of ten virgins awaiting a bridegroom (Matt 25:1)
The parable is consistent with Jewish customs
Christ is the bridegroom. The Church is His bride. (Hos 2:16-20)
Other metaphors include Shepherd & sheep, Father & children
Only five of the virgins come prepared with extra oil (Matt 25:2-4)
The lesson is that we should prepare beforehand (Mk 13:35)
Their chief concern is to shine a light (Phil 2:15)
The virgins sleep. The bridegroom arrives at midnight (Matt 25:5-7)
This may be symbolic of death, judgement and deliverance (Ex 12:29)
The five foolish virgins realize their mistake (Matt 25:8,9)
The five wise virgins enter. The door is shut. (Matt 25:10,11)
The bridegroom tells the foolish virgins "I do not know you" (Matt 25:12)
Trusting the Savior is a decision each person makes for himself

The Job - Jesus has left us a job to do (Matt 25:14-30)
Jesus compares the Kingdom to a job (Matt 25:14-15)
God doles out responsibility based on ability (Matt 25:15)
Each believer can be equally pleasing to God
The first two servants invest wisely (Matt 25:16-17)
The third servant makes an unwise decision (Matt 25:18)
The master settles accounts with his servants (Matt 25:19-23)
The master is pleased with faithfulness
Believers should work as for the Lord (Col 3:23,24)

The Throne - Am I prepared to face my Creator? (Matt 25:31-46) Jesus speaks of separating sheep from goats (Matt 25:31-33) The sheep receive eternal life (Matt 25:34-40) The goats receive eternal punishment (Matt 25:45-46)

Questions to Ponder:

Am I certain I KNOW Christ? Am I trusting in Him alone to save me? Are my thoughts about the END times distracting me from the job at hand? Am I using my God-given talent to further God's kingdom?
