QUESTIONS THAT ECHO THROUGH THE AGES

Questions that Echo

“Do You Want to be Healed?”

Genesis 5:1-15

Question - This week's question begins in an odd location (Jn 5:1-9)

- Jesus came to Jerusalem during a feast (Jn 5:1)
- The Sheep Gate foreshadowed the cross (Jn 5:2)
- Bethesda means "House of Mercy"
- Many invalids were near the pool (Jn 5:3)
- The invalids symbolize our spiritual needs
- The first person to step into the pool would be healed (Jn 5:4)
- Note: Defendinginerrancy.com
- One man had been paralyzed 38 years (Jn 5:5)
- Jesus asked an odd question (Jn 5:6)
- The man was focused on one method
- The man said he had no one to help him (Jn 5:7)
- Jesus asks us if we want to be healed spiritually
- Jesus made a command (Jn 5:8)
- The timing of the miracle would draw attention (Jn 5:9)

Aggression - Jesus has a way of causing division (Jn 5:10-13)

- The Jews focused on the Law (Jn 5:10)
- The man focused on the Healer (Jn 5:11)
- The Jews wanted to know who told the man to break the Law (Jn 5:12)
- The man did not know (Jn 5:13)

Impression - Wherever Jesus went, He made an impression (Jn 5:14-15)

- Jesus made an impossible command (Jn 5:14)
- We are thoroughly sinful (Rom 3:10-12)
- The Law reveals our need for a Savior (Gal 3:23-26)
- The man now realized the miracle was due to Jesus (Jn 5:15)
- Only Jesus can heal us spiritually
- He can use us to have impact on others (Ac 17:5-6)

Application:

- Decide if you want to be healed
- Get to know the Savior
- Ask Him to make you more like Him
