

**Question** - This week's question begins in an odd location (Jn 5:1-9)

- -Jesus came to Jerusalem during a feast (Jn 5:1)
- -The Sheep Gate foreshadowed the cross (Jn 5:2)
- -Bethesda means "House of Mercy"
- -Many invalids were near the pool (Jn 5:3)
- -The invalids symbolize our spiritual needs
- -The first person to step into the pool would be healed (Jn 5:4)
- -Note: Defendinginerrancy.com
- -One man had been paralyzed 38 years (Jn 5:5)
- -Jesus asked an odd question (Jn 5:6)
- -The man was focused on one method
- -The man said he had no one to help him (Jn 5:7)
- -Jesus asks us if we want to be healed spiritually
- -Jesus made a command (Jn 5:8)
- -The timing of the miracle would draw attention (Jn 5:9)

Aggression - Jesus has a way of causing division (Jn 5:10-13)

- -The Jews focused on the Law (Jn 5:10)
- -The man focused on the Healer (Jn 5:11)
- -The Jews wanted to know who told the man to break the Law (Jn 5:12)
- -The man did not know (Jn 5:13)

Impression - Wherever Jesus went, He made an impression (Jn 5:14-15)

- -Jesus made an impossible command (Jn 5:14)
- -We are thoroughly sinful (Rom 3:10-12)
- -The Law reveals our need for a Savior (Gal 3:23-26)
- -The man now realized the miracle was due to Jesus (Jn 5:15)
- -Only Jesus can heal us spiritually
- -He can use us to have impact on others (Ac 17:5-6)

### **Application:**

- -Decide if you want to be healed
- -Get to know the Savior
- -Ask Him to make you more like Him
