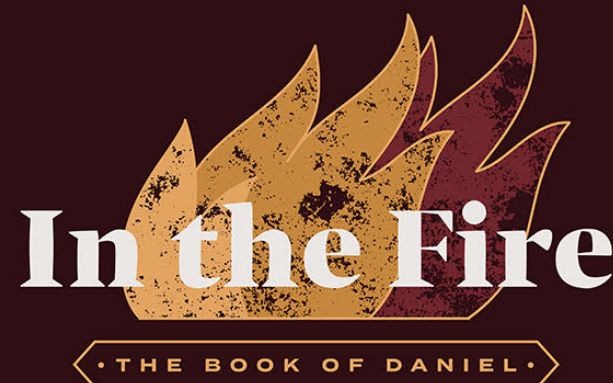

In the Fire: The Book of Daniel Daniel 3:1-30 Idol of My Eye

- Image:** The story begins today with a king who made a statue (Dan 3:1-15)
- King N made an image of gold (Dan 3:1)
 - He was possibly motivated by the dream from chapter 2 (Dan 2:37-38)
 - King N had forgotten his own words (Dan 2:46-47)
 - King N made a proclamation (Dan 3:4-6)
 - Almost everyone obeyed his command (Dan 3:7)
 - The Chaldeans accused the three young friends of Daniel (Dan 3:8)
 - The Chaldeans ignored that the 3 young men had saved their lives (Dan 2:5)
 - The Chaldeans were actually encouraging King N to disobey God (Dan 3:9-12)
 - King N was furious (Dan 3:13)
 - He questioned the three young men (Dan 3:14)
 - He threatened the three young men (Dan 3:15)
 - He questioned God’s power, even as Pharaoh had done in the past (Ex 5:2)

- Immovable:** The three young men were unwilling to compromise (Dan 3:16-25)
- The three young men answered the King (Dan 3:16)
 - They knew God would deliver them (Dan 3:17)
 - They refused to compromise (Dan 3:18)
 - They feared God more than they feared King N (Matt 10:28)
 - They obeyed the 2nd Commandment (Ex 20:4-5)
 - King N became furious (Dan 3:19a)
 - The three young men were thrown into the furnace (Dan 3:19b-23)
 - The three young men were not alone in the fire (Dan 3:24-25)

- Impact:** God can have an impact in you and through you (Dan 3:26-30)
- King N calls God “The Most High God” (Dan 3:26)
 - King N is reminded of the greatness of God (Dan 3:28)

Application:

- Be sure you have trusted the Savior
- Clear away your idols
- Spend a little time with God every day
