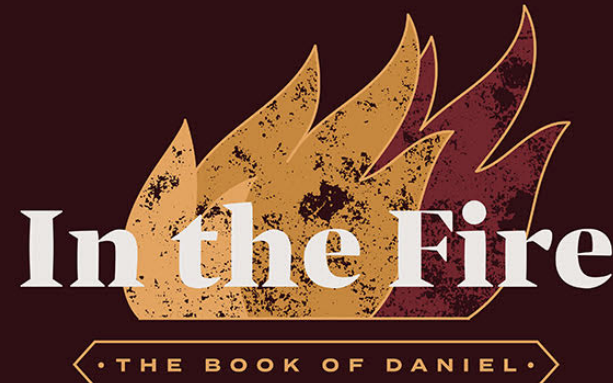

In the Fire: The Book of Daniel

Daniel 4:1-37

Neither Man, Nor Beast

Taught him: God uses a dream to get King N's attention (Dan 4:1-27)

- King N honors God (Dan 4:1)
- He speaks of God personally (Dan 4:2)
- He speaks of God's wonders (Dan 4:3)
- God gives N a disturbing dream (Dan 4:4,5)
- N's magicians are unable to interpret the dream (Dan 4:7)
- The magicians are exposed as fools (Dan 2:4-7)
- King N calls on Daniel as a last resort (Dan 4:8,9)
- King N has forgotten his own words (Dan 2:47)
- King N relates the dream (Dan 4:10-12)
- The dream is disturbing (Dan 4:13-14)
- The dream also includes hope (Dan 4:15-17)
- King N asks Daniel to interpret the dream (Dan 4:18)
- There is good and bad news (Dan 4:24-26)
- God wants people to have humble hearts (Lk 14:11)

Not him: God's judgment falls on King N (Dan 4:28-33)

- King N makes an arrogant statement (Dan 4:28)
- God wants people to have humble hearts (1 Pet 5:6)
- God reminds King N about the dream (Dan 4:31)
- God brings down the curse on King N (Dan 4:33)
- The OT speaks of blessing and cursing (Deut 30:15,19)
- The NT speaks of blessing and cursing (Gal 6:7,8)

Got him: God brings King N to complete surrender (Dan 4:34-37)

- King N admits that God is the Most High (Dan 4:34)
- King N worships Almighty God (Dan 4:36,37)
- God's people should pray for revival

Application:

- Be certain you've surrendered to Christ
- Make a list of "distant" people
- Pray for revival
