# FAITH IN EXILE 1 PETER

## Holy & Wholly His

**Hope is:** Hope is the certainty of God's promises (1 Pet 1:13)

- Prepare our minds and be sober-minded (1 Pet 1:13)
- Our minds can be renewed (Rom 12:2)
- Wisdom is of greatest importance (Prov 4:7)
- Renewed minds affect our daily lives
- We can have true and eternal hope (1 Pet 1:13)
- Our hope should be in God alone (Ps 121:1-8)
- Hope will be fully realized when we see Christ (1 Pet 1:13)
- Christ has given us access to the Father (Heb 4:14-16)

**Holy as:** God wants believers to be as Holy as He is (1 Pet 1:14-21)

- Do not be conformed to former ignorance (1 Pet 1:14)
- God calls us to be holy (1 Pet 1:15,16)
- How? God makes this possible partly now, partly later
- Peter gradually became a different person (Lk 5:8)
- First, one must become a child of God (1 Pet 1:17; 1 Jn 3:1)
- One must be ransomed (1 Pet 1:18)
- The payment is the precious blood of Christ (1 Pet 1:19)
- He sacrificed Himself for our sake (1 Pet 1:20)
- One becomes a believer through Christ (1 Pet 1:21)
- Our faith and hope should be in God (1 Pet 1:21)
- Positionally, believers are seated in Heaven (Eph 2:6)
- Positionally, believers are already sanctified; i.e. made holy (1 Cor 1:2)
- Hagiazo (hag-ee-ad'-zo) = to make holy, consecrate, sanctify

**Wholly His:** Ultimately God wants all of you, all the time (1 Pet 1:22-25)

- God's truth purifies us (1 Pet 1:22)
- God calls us to love each other (Gal 6:2)
- A new birth is the beginning of eternal life (1 Pet 1:23)
- A complete change takes place (2 Cor 5:17)
- This temporal life fades like the grass (1 Pet 1:24-25)

## Application:

- Be certain you are a Child of God.
- Being "Holy as God" is a miraculous work that God Does and Only God Can Do in His children
- Being "Wholly His" means we love Him and live with eternity in mind
