

Three Claims - Jesus makes three astonishing claims (Jn 14:1-7)

Jesus speaks words of comfort (Jn 14:1; Phil 4:6)

Jesus prepares a place for believers (Jn 14:2-3)

Jesus gives believers security (Jn 10:27-29)

Jesus claims to be the way, truth and life (Jn 14:4-6)

The Way is narrow (Matt 7:13-14)
