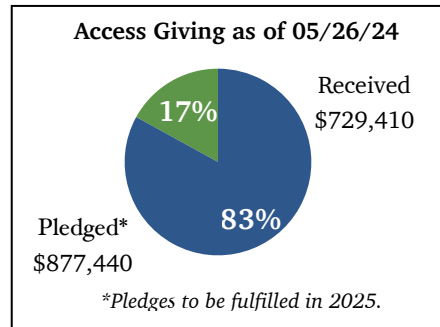
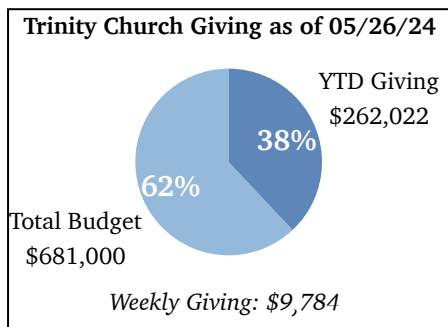
Trinity Women's Poolside Brunch | June 8th

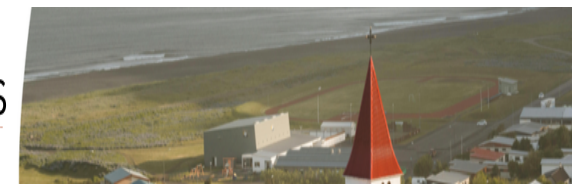

It's Not About Me Jonah 1-3

Correction: God corrects His children (Jon 1:1-17)
Jonah's story begins with direct disobedience (Jon 1:1-2)
Nineveh had been exceedingly cruel to Israel
Jonah ran from Nineveh and from God (Jon 1:3)
God sent a storm (Jon 1:4)
The crew of the ship called out to their idols (Jon 1:5)
Jonah relates his whole story
The crew become very fearful (Jon 1:10)
Jonah instructs them to throw him overboard (Jon 1:11-12)
This event foreshadows Christ (John 12:32-33)
The words of the crew foreshadow Christ (Jon 1:14; Matt 27:22-24; Lk 23:34)
Jonah is sacrificed for the crew's sake (Jon 1:15)
The crew comes to faith in God (Jon 1:16)
Jonah is swallowed by a whale (Jon 1:17)

Communion: Jonah calls out to God (Jon 2:1-10)
Jonah reaches rock bottom (Jon 2:1-2)
Jonah acknowledges God (Jon 2:3)
God is merciful (Jon 2:4)
God is often our last resort (Jon 2:7)
Only God can save through Christ (Jon 2:9)
God works in strange ways (Jon 2:10)

Comeback: God answers Jonah's prayer (Jon 3:1-10)
God gives Jonah the original command (Jon 3:1-2)
Jonah preaches to Nineveh (Jon 3:3-4)
The entire city turns to God (Jon 3:5)
God responds with mercy and forgiveness (Jon 3:10; Rom 5:8)
