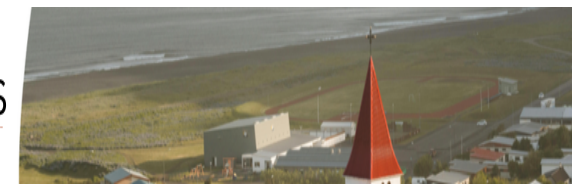
Mission Trip Info Meeting | Sunday June 23rd

A Young Man Names Saul Acts 7:54 through 9:8

Callousness: Apathetic, cold-blooded, uncaring (Ac 7:54-60)
Stephen preached to an angry crowd (Ac 7:54-58)
Saul was overseeing Stephen's execution (Ac 7:58)
Stephen prayed (Ac 7:59)
Stephen asked God to forgive his tormentors (Ac 7:60)
People have hardened their hearts in the past (Gen 6:5)
People harden their hearts today (Rom 1:21)
People will harden their hearts in the future (1 Tim 4:1-2)
Sometimes it only takes one person to make a difference

Conversion: Saul's conversion was dramatic (Ac 9:1-8)
Saul persecuted believers (Ac 9:1-2; 26:9-11)
Saul was actually persecuting Jesus (Ac 9:3-5; 22:6-8)
God can humble His enemies (Ac 9:8-9)
Paul was forgiven but carried regret (1 Tim 1:15)
Paul was not ashamed of the gospel (Rom 1:16-17)
The word of the cross is the power of God (1 Cor 1:18)

Compassion: Saul became a compassionate man
He loved the Jews (Rom 9:3-4)
He wanted everyone to come to faith (1 Cor 9:19)
He loved believers (Phil 1:7)

Application:

Be sure you know Jesus Christ
Ask Him to help you not be ashamed of Him
Ask Him to help you tell someone about Him this week
