

Order in a Broken World 1 Corinthians 11:2-15

Hats: Does God require women to wear hats or veils?

- -A passage that has caused much debate (1 Cor 11:4-5)
- -In the OT God established a number of symbols
- -In the NT God replaced those symbols with deeper truths
- -It would be inconsistent to suddenly require hats
- -Comparison of OT vs NT
- -Circumcision (Gen 17:10; Rom 2:29)
- -Ten Commandments (Ex 31:18; 2 Cor 3:3)
- -The Temple (1 Cor 6:19)
- -Sacrifices (Heb 10:10-14)
- -High Priest (Heb 4:14)
- -The Priesthood (1 Pet 2:4-5)
- -NT requirements of Gentile believers (Ac 15:28-29)

Hair: Many scholars view this passage as dealing with hair (1 Cor 11:2-9)

- -Paul encourages the Corinthians (1 Cor 11:2)
- -There is Order in God's World (1 Cor 11:3)
- -"akatakalyptō" = Uncover, Unveil, Bare
- -Could refer to "Veil" or "Hair"
- -Corinthian church still practiced pagan rituals (1 Cor 11:4-5)
- -As a sign of mourning, women would partially shave their hair
- -Men would adorn their hair effeminately
- -These practices were condemned in the OT (Jer 16:5-6; Lev 19:27)
- -These practices were condemned in the NT (1 Cor 11:6-7)
- -God created two genders (1 Cor 11:7; Gen 1:26-27; 2:21-22)
- -God created men and women with different roles (1 Cor 11:8-9; Gen 2:18)

Harmony: God has assigned complimentary roles (1 Cor 11:10-15)

- -The wife has a special role (1 Cor 11:10)
- -God made both genders inter-dependent (1 Cor 11:11-12)
- -God made both genders for His glory (1 Cor 11:13-15)

Application:

- -Acknowledge that Christ is Lord of all
- -Be thankful for your God-given role
- -Live to honor and reflect God's image
