- The most famous verse points to eternal life (Jn 3:16)
- God wants us to be with Him forever
- God wants us to weigh that decision heavily (Mk 8:36-37)
- God offers eternal life for free (Jn 10:27-29)
- God offers to adopt us (Rom 8:15)
- God offers to transform us (2 Cor 5:17)
- God offers to deliver us (Col 1:13)
- God offers us assurance (1 Jn 5:11-13)

Hope for Life: How would God have me live my life?

- God wants to be our top priority (Col 1:1-2; Matt 6:33)
- The victory is already won (Jn 16:33)
- God gives us purpose for living
- Worship (Ps 29:2)
- Discipleship (Col 2:6-7)
- Community (Acts 2:46; Gal 6:2)
- Mission (Matt 9:36-38)
- Do everything to glorify God (1 Cor 10:31)

- Sometimes depression can be clinical
- Sometimes you just need a simple plan
- Connect with your Father (Job 1:20; Job 13:15)
- Connect with a human being (Matt 22:39)
- Do something out of the ordinary (Prov 17:22)
- Begin with the most famous verse (Jn 3:16)
