

This verse beautifully describes Ginger Downie's heart's cry, and now she is Home. Ginger peacefully entered the house of the LORD on December 22, at the home of one of her sons near Baton Rouge. Our dear friend graciously fought Stage 4 Hodgkins Lymphoma, chemotherapy, Covid, nerve pain, and many years of physical suffering before the Lord Jesus called her home.

Ginger lived close to the Lord through it all and was such an example of servanthood with every opportunity she was given. She taught Math at NCS, substituted for years, and most recently served students who needed extended time on the ACT and other tests. She has attended Trinity for decades and was often the last one standing at the sink washing dishes after our shared meals. Ginger joined right in with our Grief Share ministry leading a small group and encouraging others to find hope and help during their times of grieving. She also faithfully prayed for our church leaders, our church family, and for specific needs that were shared with her.
