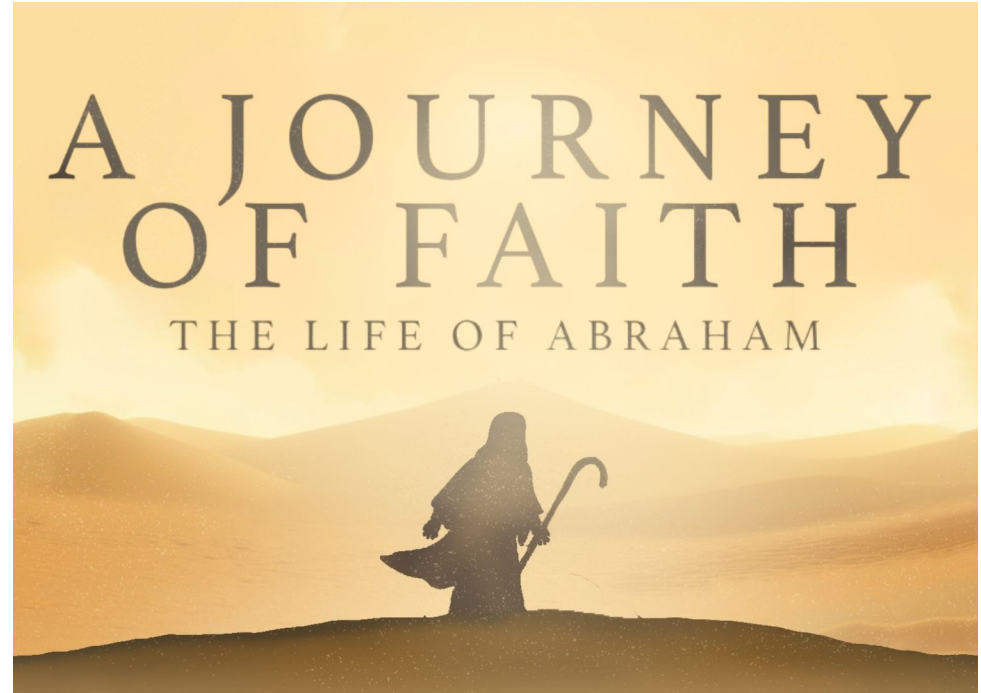

"He's My Boy, Ish..."

Genesis 16:1-15

Cause: Sometimes one decision can have great impact (Gen 16:1-3)

-Sarai had borne no children (Gen 16:1)

-God's children receive blessings and trials (Prov 37:1-9)

-Hagar was an Egyptian maid (Gen 16:1)

-Hagar was probably a gift from Pharaoh (Gen 12:15-16)

-Abram and Sarai make a poor decision (Gen 16:2)

-Hagar became Abram's 2nd wife (Gen 16:3)

-Little decisions can have lasting consequences (Prov 6:10-11; Isa 28:10)

Consequence: When we sin, consequences are inevitable (Gen 16:4-15)

-Hagar conceives and scorns Sarai (Gen 16:4)

-Consequences are immediate (Gen 16:5)

-An angel advises Hagar (Gen 16:7-9; Prov 15:1)

-God gives Hagar hope (Gen 16:10-12)

-Hagar gives birth to Ishmael (Gen 16:15)

Comparison: All religions are not the same

-Making a declaration is not the same as Saving Faith
(Rom 10:9-10; Eph 2:8-9)

-Allah and Almighty God are not the same

-Ishmael and Muslims are not the enemy (Jn 3:16)

Application:

-Make your decisions prayerfully

-Trust that God can cause all things to work for good

-Remember Christ died to save the world
